
Giant Steps Therapeutic Equestrian Center was founded in 1998 by Robert Pope and Lee Justice; what started as a small endeavor serving 10 riders in a backyard in Petaluma has grown to serve over 120 participants per week, with a dedicated team of certified instructors and volunteers offering a range of therapeutic riding programs designed to enhance physical, emotional, and social wellbeing for individuals with disabilities.

Join us in this exciting journey as we make 2025 a year of transformation and growth! Together, we can continue turning dreams into reality and changing lives—one ride at a time.


